

Gradient Seattle, WA

From the South (including SeaTac Airport)

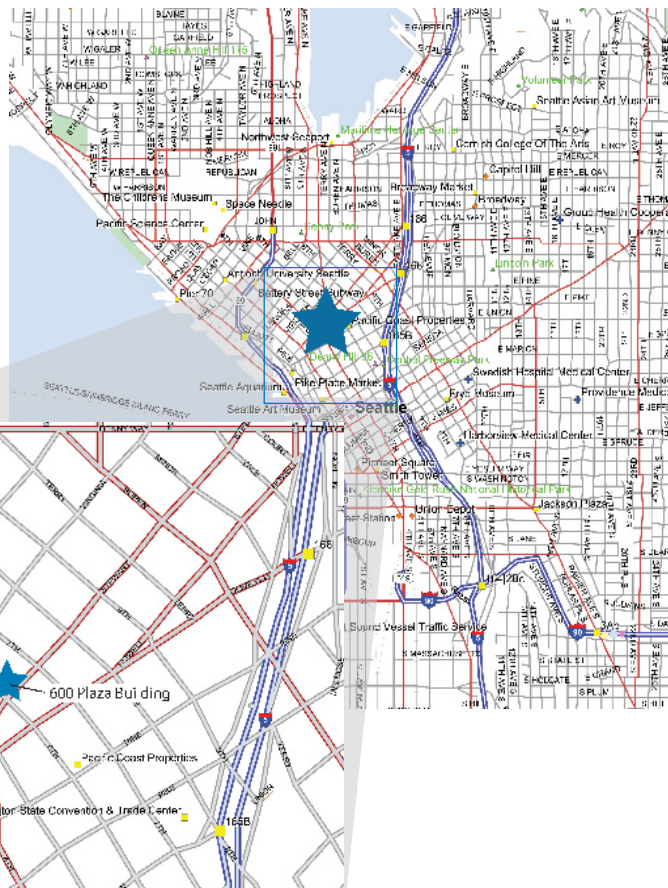
- From the airport follow the signs to I-5
- Take I-5 Northbound to the Madison Street Exit (Exit No. 165)
- Cross over I-5 on Madison Street
- Immediately turn right onto 6th Avenue (one way going North)
- Proceed 0.5 miles to the Plaza 600 Building
- Corner of Stewart St. and 6th Avenue
- Plaza 600 is the dark glass building with white vertical stripes

From the East (Bellevue, Kirkland, Redmond via I-90)

- Take I-90 Westbound across Lake Washington
- Stay on I-90 through Mount Baker Tunnel to the I-5 Interchange
- Take I-5 North (towards Vancouver, Canada)
- Exit I-5 at the Madison Street Exit (Exit No. 165)
- Turn left and cross over I-5 on Madison Street
- Immediately turn right onto 6th Avenue (one way going North)
- Proceed 0.5 miles to the Plaza 600 Building
- Corner of Stewart St. and 6th Avenue
- Plaza 600 is the dark glass building with white vertical stripes

From the West (the Olympic Peninsula)

- Take the Seattle-Bainbridge Island Ferry to Seattle
- If driving, leave the Ferry terminal onto Marion Street
- Proceed up the hill to 6th Avenue
- Turn left onto 6th Avenue (one way going North)
- Proceed 0.5 miles to the Plaza 600 Building
- Corner of Stewart St. and 6th Avenue
- Plaza 600 is the dark glass building with vertical white stripes
- If walking, exit ferry terminal via Marion Street Pedestrian Bridge
- Cross over Alaskan Way, and it becomes Marion Street
- Walk uphill to 3rd Avenue
- Turn left and walk approximately 0.5 miles to Stewart Street
- Turn right and walk 3 blocks to the Plaza 600



From the North

- Take I-5 Southbound into downtown Seattle
- Take the Stewart Street Exit (Exit No. 166)
- Proceed 0.5 miles to the Plaza 600 Building
- Corner of Stewart St. and 6th Avenue
- Plaza 600 is the dark glass building with white vertical stripes

By Public Transportation

- Multiple bus lines run through downtown Seattle near the office. The primary bus corridor through downtown Seattle runs along 3rd Avenue. If taking one of the buses that runs along 3rd Avenue (including the RapidRide C or D lines), get off at the 3rd and Virginia stop. Walk 3 blocks east to 6th Avenue, and one block south to Stewart St. The Plaza 600 Building is on the east side of 6th Avenue between Westlake Avenue and Stewart St.
- If using a bus that runs through the Metro Bus Tunnel (or the Link light rail system), get off at Westlake Center station and exit onto 4th Avenue. Walk one block North to Stewart St. and then 2 blocks East to the Plaza 600 Building.
